- Please read these instructions carefully before opening the exam paper. Feel free to refer back to these instructions during the exam if necessary.

- Please complete this exam in one sitting. It should take you approximately an hour to complete.
- This exam is given on the honor system.
 - You **MAY NOT** look at or refer to your written or printed lecture notes during the test. Please keep them put away during the exam.
 - You **MAY NOT** use your Bible for the Scripture Memory portion of the test. Keep your Bible closed until you have finished the Scripture Memory portion.
 - An open Bible may be used for the remainder of the exam. This should be a “clean” Bible with no printed or personal notes in it.
- Be sure to write your name and the date at the top of the exam page.
- The exam is worth 100 points and is composed of four sections:
 - **Scripture Memory.** Verses must be written from memory from the Bible Version of your choice. Please write which Bible Version you are using on the exam sheet. (Each Scripture reference is worth **5 points**.)
 - **Short Answer.** Fill in the blanks. (Each answer is worth **2 points**.)
 - **Matching.** Match each book of the New Testament with its theme statement. (Each answer is worth **1 point**.)
 - **True/False Questions.** Read each statement carefully and write TRUE if the statement is entirely true and accurate; write FALSE if any part of the statement is untrue or inaccurate. (Each answer is worth **1 point**.)
- Please self-correct your exam.
 - **Use a different color pen for corrections** than the one you used to take the exam.
 - Please write at the top of the first page the approximate amount of time you required to complete the exam.
 - Use your Bible to check your Scripture memory verses. Circle errors.
 - Use the distributed handouts and your lecture notes to try to check your answers. Put an “X” next to incorrect answers; Place a question mark “?” next to answers you are not sure are correct.
